PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Sagaponack on the 15th day of August, 2016 adopted the following Local Law:

LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 2016

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING VILLAGE CODE CHAPTER 52,
DOGS AND OTHER ANIMALS, TO REGULATE DOGS ON THE
ATLANTIC OCEAN BEACH**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SAGAPONACK AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this local law is to regulate the presence of dogs on the beach of the Atlantic Ocean.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF VILLAGE CODE § 52-2.

Village Code § 52-2(C) is enacted to read as follows:

C. Any provision herein to the contrary notwithstanding no person owning, harboring or having the control or custody of a dog shall permit the dog on the Atlantic Ocean beach between the crest of the dune and the water's edge between 9 AM and 5 PM between May 15 and September 15.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

Should any part or provision of this local law be decided by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the local law as a whole nor any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law.
