TOWN OF SOUTHAMPTON BEACH PARKING INFORMATION

Beach Parking Permits are required at all Town Beach Recreation Facilities beginning in May when an attendant is on duty and at all times July—Labor Day. They may be purchased throughout the season at all Town beaches (weather permitting).

Full-season permits are required at all Trustee/Town Access Roads July 1 through Labor Day.

Pre-Season Purchase Information:

- Memorial Day Weekend through June 25: Permits are available and required at Ponquogue, Tiana, Foster Memorial (Long), Flying Point and Sagg Main Beaches, weekends only, 9:30 am to 4:30 pm, until all facilities are opened full-time on June 26, 2010.
- May 3 through Labor Day: Permits are available at the Parks & Recreation Office, 6 Newtown Road, Hampton Bays from 8:30 am—4:00 pm, Monday—Friday.
- May 3 through June 25: Permits are available at Town Hall, 116 Hampton Road, Southampton, 10:00 am—2:00 pm, Monday, Thursday, Friday.
- Permits are non-transferable and should be applied to the vehicle at time of purchase.

Beaches open full-time/7-days per week June 26 through Labor Day.

PROOF OF RESIDENCY for Full-Season Permits

HOMEOWNERS: Original, current tax bill with the name matching the name on the vehicle registration OR a current vehicle registration with a Town of Southampton address and a valid driver's license with a Town of Southampton address matching the name on the vehicle registration

YEAR-ROUND RENTERS: Current driver's license and vehicle registration with a Town address OR two utility bills (electric, phone or cable—one must be current and one from a winter month in the previous year)

Residents with local PO boxes must show some form of proof for a physical mailing address within the Town of Southampton.

NOTE: A LEASE IS NOT AN ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF RESIDENCY

June 26-Labor Day: Beach Parking Permits are available at the beaches listed below, 7 days per week.

MOTORCYCLE AND RENTAL PERMITS PROVIDE PARKING PRIVILEGES AND BEACH ACCESS TO TOWN BATHING BEACHES ONLY.

Unless otherwise posted, lifeguards are on duty, 10:00 am—5:00 pm, when bathing beaches are open.

BEACH PARKING PERMITS ACCEPTED AT EACH LOCATION

May 15—June 25 : Permits are required 9:00 am—6:00 pm only if an attendant is on duty.

July 1—Labor Day: Permits are required at all times, 9:00 am—6:00 pm, at all Beach Recreation Facilities and Town/Trustee Access Roads.
